The 1992 Treaty of Maastricht created the EU and established freedom of movement and residence for persons in the EU. In 2004, the EU adopted Directive 2004/38/EC, on the right of EU citizens and their family members to move and reside freely within the EU.

The Impact of Brexit on the Free Movement of Persons

One of the four fundamental freedoms of EU law is the free movement of persons. The most securely protected group of persons under Community law is employed persons, or workers. Under Article 39 (1) EC 'Freedom of movement of workers shall be secured within the Community.'

Free Movement of Persons Freedom of movement for workers is based on Regulation No 1612/68 which states in its preamble that "mobility of labour within the Community must be one of the means by which the worker is guaranteed the possibility of improving his living and working conditions and promoting his social advancement".

Free Movement of Persons - European Commission

Freedom of movement applies to all EU member states, although restrictions can be placed on new members to the EU. It also applies to Norway, Iceland and Lichtenstein (who make up the EEA alongside the 27 EU member states) and Switzerland. UK citizens are treated as EU citizens until 31 December 2020.

Free movement of workers is a fundamental principle of the Treaty enshrined in Article 45 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and developed by EU secondary legislation and the Case law of the Court of Justice. EU citizens are entitled to: look for a job in another EU country. work there without needing a work permit.

One of the four freedoms enjoyed by EU citizens is the free movement of workers. However, persons with disabilities cannot yet fully enjoy their freedom of movement and have difficulties accessing mainstream goods and services, under the same conditions as any other EU citizen.
