The goal with any type of accommodations for anxiety is to put a plan in place that helps a child learn to manage anxiety and includes a weaning process as their anxiety improves. The steps below outline how IEPs and 504s are created to help children with anxiety succeed at school. As I always mention, all children with anxiety are unique.

{Homework and Tests} Anxiety Accommodations Extended time on tests will ease the pressure on anxious children, and just knowing that the time is available may obviate the need to use it. Sometimes anxious children become distracted when they see other children working on their tests or turning them in, they may inaccurately assume that they don ' t know the material as well.

Sample 504s/IEPs for Teachers. Your students OCD or anxiety symptoms may qualify as a disability if they are severe enough that they impact his/her ability to learn. In these cases, the student who is in public school is eligible for a 504 Plan or an Individualized Education Plan (IEP). With a 504 or an IEP Plan, accommodations are made so that the student has access to the curriculum in the same way their peers do.

Addressing any ADHD student's needs in your classroom plan, whether the accommodation is in their IEP or not, will significantly benefit the overall

Talking to a therapist who specializes in anxiety and cognitive behavioral therapy can provide a whole range of benefits and help teach important anxiety management skills. Testing Accommodations When test anxiety is severe, it may help asking your child ' s teacher for accommodations — especially if your child has an IEP or a 504 plan .

~~Accommodations and Resources to Help Students' Test Anxiety~~

IEPs can include emotional supports, such as S goals/objectives in the social/emotional section of the IEP. Counseling or social skills can be related services on an IEP. Or a 504 Plan could have accommodations such as coming into the classroom after the class has settled down to reduce anxiety due to noise or using seating preferences.

~~DEVELOPING APPROPRIATE IEPs FOR STUDENTS WITH ANXIETY OR ...~~

Introducing New Concepts/Lessons. Give extended time on tests and/or separate test-taking space to reduce performance anxiety. Allow use of word banks, cheat sheets, or fact cards for tests (for students who freeze or " go blank " during in-class tests). Set time limits for homework or reduce the amount of homework.

One of the most important parts of an IEP are the accommodations that are outlined for the child. These accommodations are developed during the IEP team meetings, along with the measurable goals and objectives, and are updated at least annually.

An IEP is a legal document stating that the child is entitled to these [accommodations]. Teachers don ' t have the option, legally, to ignore this. It ' s a contract — a legal statement incumbent on the teachers. ” Nonetheless, you and your teen must be diligent about making sure accommodations are applied.

Students with anxiety may require an Individualized Education Program (IEP) if they require Specially Designed Instruction and/or Related Services to address the anxiety. If a student ' s needs can be met with only accommodations, a Section 504 Agreement can be implemented.

~~When Anxiety Interferes with a Student ' s Ability to Learn ...~~

Among many others, accommodations include extended time for tests, audio recordings of lectures and books, and preferential seating. It ' s important that accommodations fit your needs. Extra time on tests may work well for students with learning disabilities or ADHD, but those accommodations may not be helpful if you have OCD.
