Osteomyelitis of the jaws is osteomyelitis (which is infection and inflammation of the bone marrow, sometimes abbreviated to OM) which occurs in the bones of the jaws (i.e. maxilla or the mandible). Historically, osteomyelitis of the jaws was a common complication of odontogenic infection (infections of the teeth).

Acute and secondary chronic osteomyelitis of the jaws is caused mostly by a bacterial focus (odontogenic disease, pulpal and periodontal infection, extraction wounds, foreign bodies, and infected fractures). SUPPURATIVE OSTEOMYELITIS

Source of infection is usually an adjacent focus of infection associated with teeth or with local trauma. It is a polymicrobial infection, predominating anaerobes such as Bacteroids, Porphyromonas or Prevotella.

Staphylococci may be a cause when an open fracture is involved.
