What are the parts of a tree? Roots- anchor the tree in the ground and adsorb water and minerals from the soil Trunk- strongest part of the tree providing support for the rest of the tree;contains 4 parts Outer Bark- outer part of the trunk: is dead tissue;protects the living parts underneath. Branch- lateral extensions of the trunk that grow leaves, flowers, fruit and seeds.

Top layer of forest where birds nest and leaves grow. Understory: Many insects, small mammals, and reptiles that need shelter live here. Underbrush: Shrubbery, ferns and younger trees, mammals like rabbits and deer live here. Forest floor: Ground cover and soil. Worms, insects, decomposers, and burrowing creatures found here.
